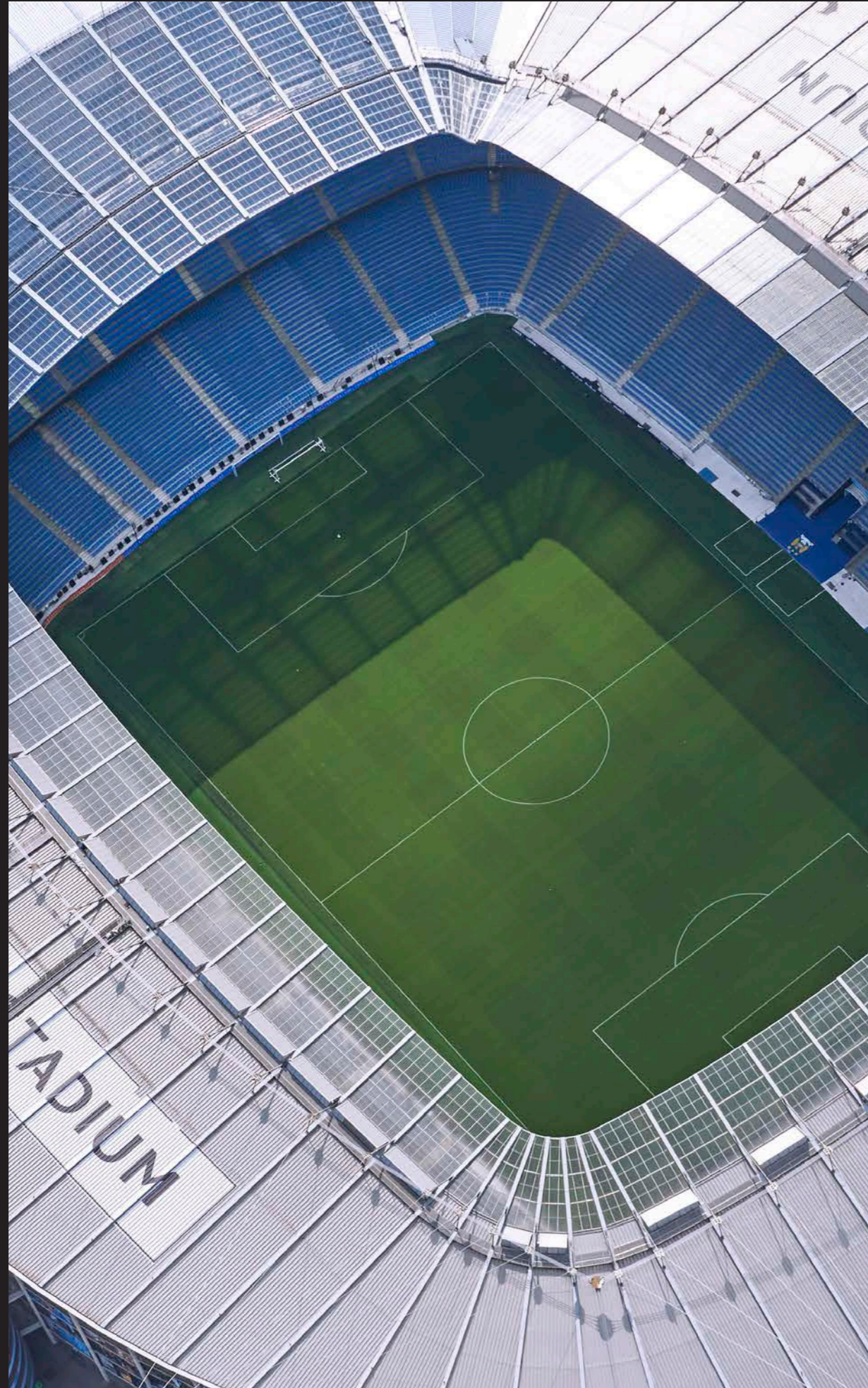
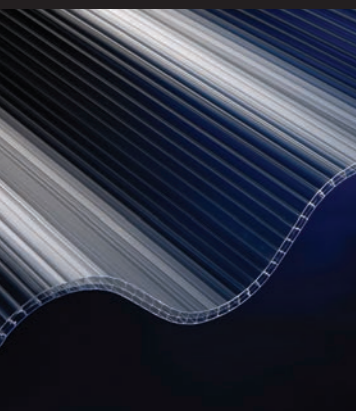

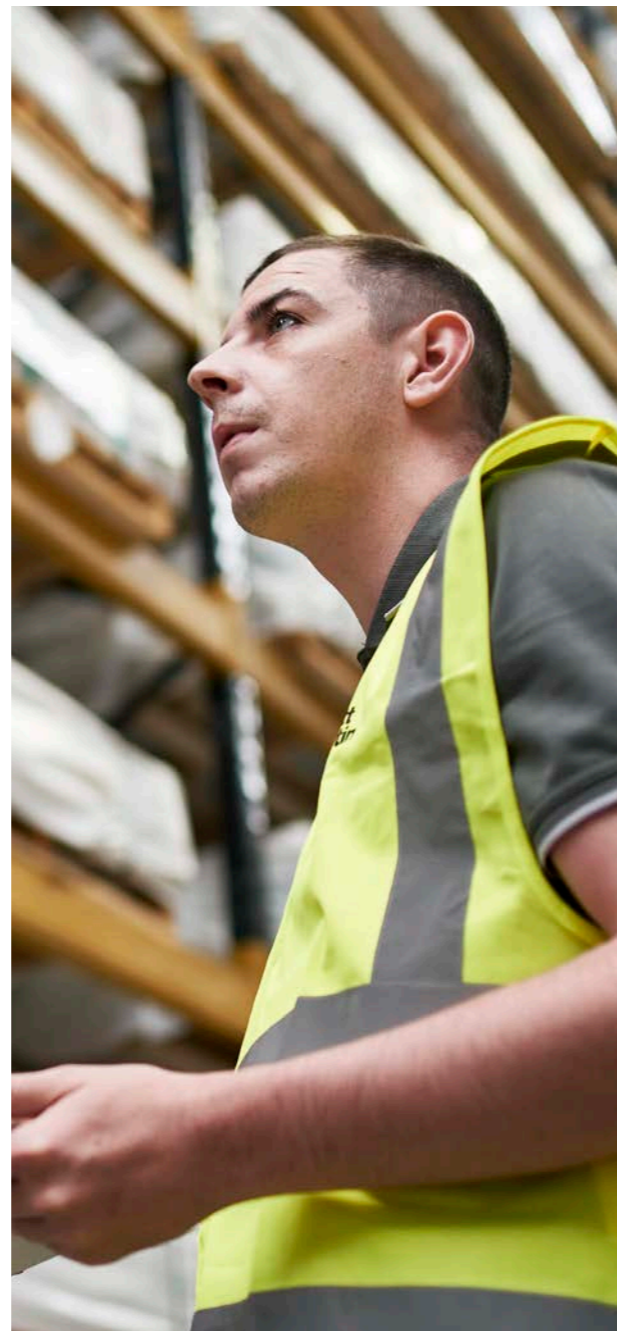

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have 7 GCSE's at Grade C or above or equivalent, including Maths and English and at least one Science/Technical Subject.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Apprenticeship positions are advertised online via the Brett Martin website brettmartin.com

SELECTION PROCESS

If short listed, applicants will be invited to an aptitude test, followed by an interview. The successful applicant will then be offered a place on the programme.

DURATION

Programme is 4 years in duration, after which time apprentices may be offered a permanent position and the opportunity for further career progression / education.

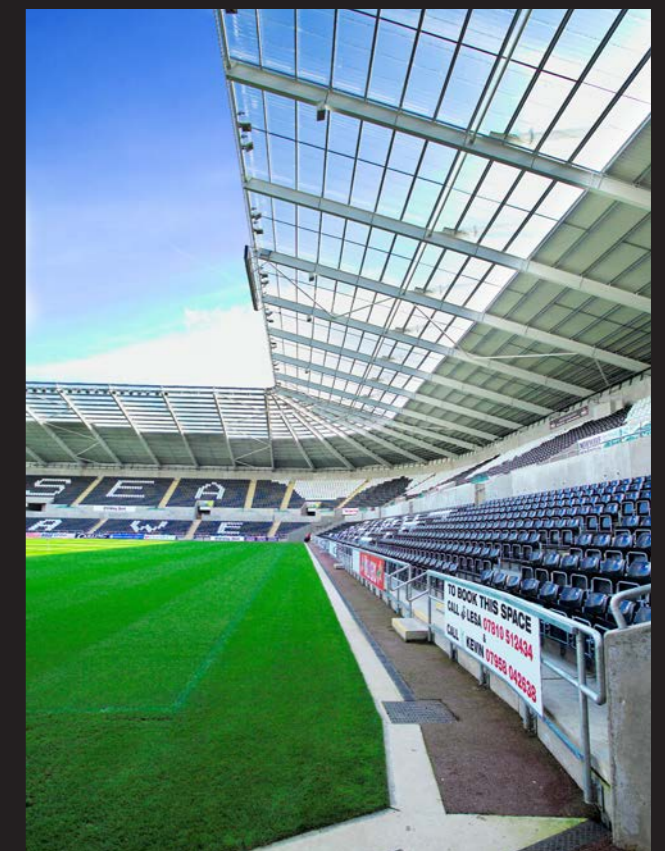
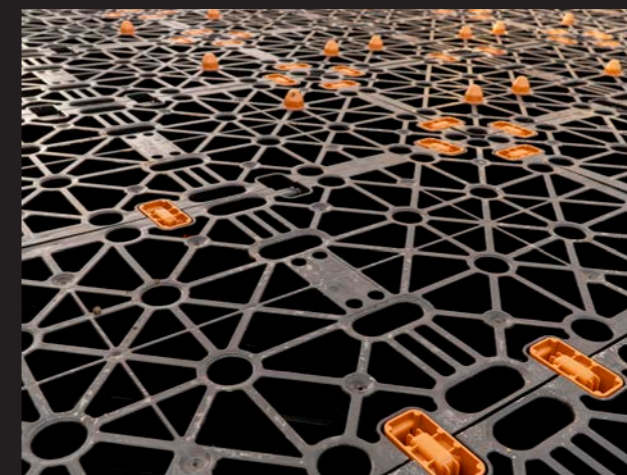
